### Only available from uniform shop

- ♦ Skirts (sports and everyday), Sloppy joe, tracksuit pants, sports shorts.

### Available from Millers in Temora but also available elsewhere.

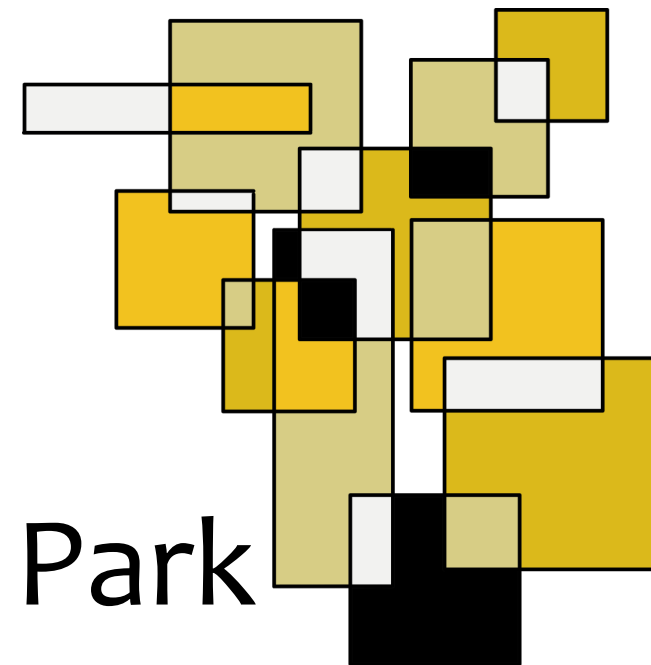
- ♦ Microfibre jumper, tracksuit pants, boys and girls pants, shorts.

### Only available elsewhere

- ♦ Jacket, Shoes, Sports Shoes, Socks, Cap

The only markings or logos allowed on any item of the uniform are the school logo and the student's name. Millers in Temora is able to embroider the school logo onto any item of the uniform.

## Everyday Polo Shirt



Available from the School Uniform Shop

Worn with one of the following:

### Black Shorts



Must be of an appropriate length

Or

### Black Pants



No other markings or logos other than school logo

Please note that during terms 1 and 4, the policy is No Hat No Play, and the Black Bucket Hat must be worn when outside.

During terms 2 and 3 a hat is optional, and either the bucket hat or the cap may be worn.

### Black Cap



The school logo may be embroidered onto any of the above items. **NO** other markings or logos apart from the student's name are permitted

### Shoes

To ensure your child's safety it is important they wear appropriate footwear. For everyday classes this means a school standard, leather shoe, preferably in black, with a leather upper and leather tongue.

For sports days, sports shoes are required.

### Socks

Black or white socks are required, with no other markings

**Straight Black Jacket**



Internal lining must be black, yellow or grey. If the jacket has a hood it must be detachable or able to fold away.

**Scarf**

A scarf, in school colours, may also be worn.

The school logo may be embroidered onto any of the above items. **NO** other markings or logos apart from the student's name are permitted

**Black Tracksuit Pants**



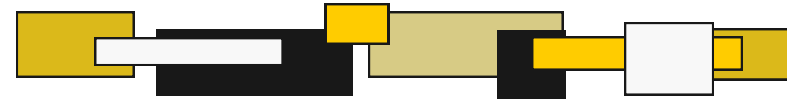

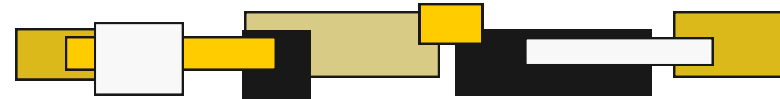
