Cupcakes will be available from the canteen at recess for \$1.

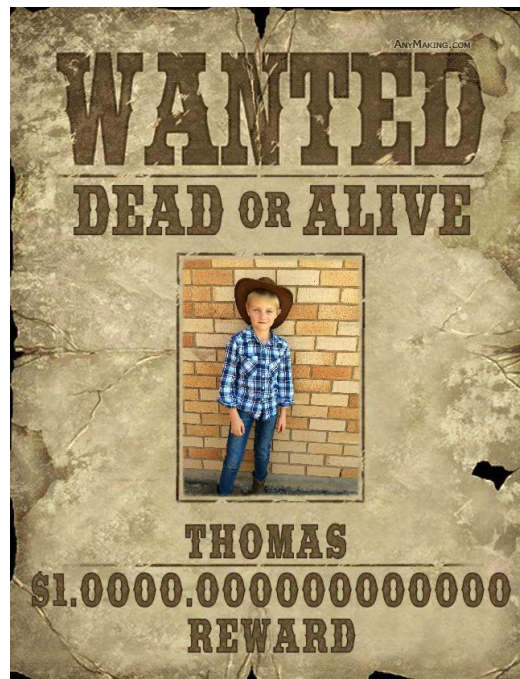

I love Lucy Appeal

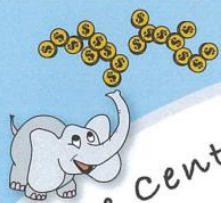
Please support a local family!

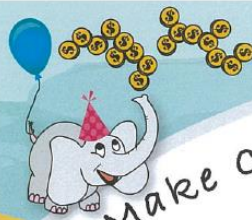

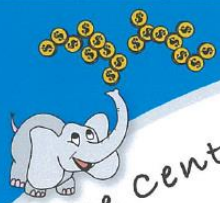
