Principal's Report

Dear Families,

Each year our school is involved in the Tell Them From Me survey. Students participate in the survey twice each year, while parents and teachers are invited to participate in the Semester 2 survey. The survey collects valuable information that we use to refine our programs as we have access to valuable data on what our community thinks about the school, the engagement of students and how

effective our programs are. I encourage every student and their families to participate in this year's survey. We cannot identify individual responses as all responses are anonymous. The more responses we get with genuine reflection the more valuable the feedback is for our school. Information will be sent home shortly to every family.

The Department of Education has launched an exciting initiative to continue to improve literacy and numeracy teaching in our schools. All schools with a primary enrolment are having a new position created starting in 2022, Assistant Principal Curriculum and Instruction (APCI). This new role in schools is designed to provide instructional leadership, where teachers are supported to deliver the highest quality literacy and numeracy teaching. We are fortunate that Aria Park and Ardlethan Central School have joined together to create a full time APCI position that will support both schools. We are currently in the process of appointing our new APCI through the merit selection process. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the school.



As our RAP students transition from using Moodle to the Microsoft Teams platform, we are taking the opportunity to improve the physical environment that our students work in. That means that the senior study will be refurnished to make the space more appropriate for modern Stage 6 studies. We are investigating the best solutions so that students have dedicated workspaces and comfortable, safe chairs. We are also investigating the provision of upgraded technology in the room. I am looking forward to seeing the upgraded study before the end of the year.

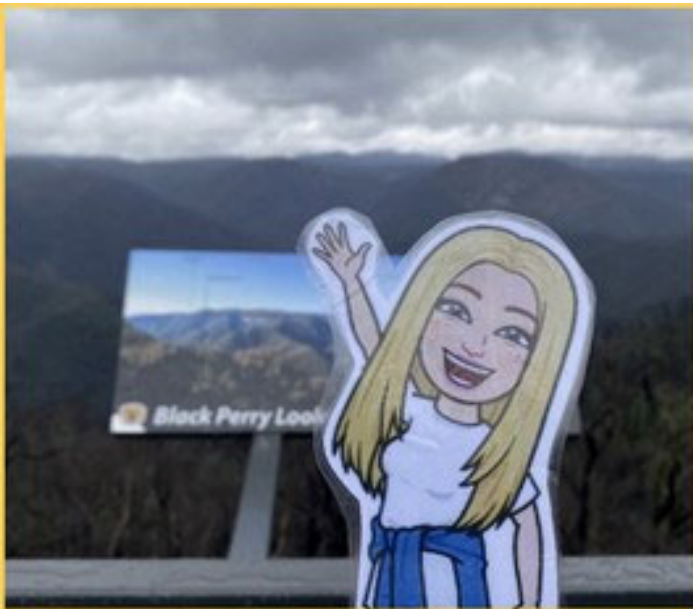
Mini Miss Pearsall Adventures

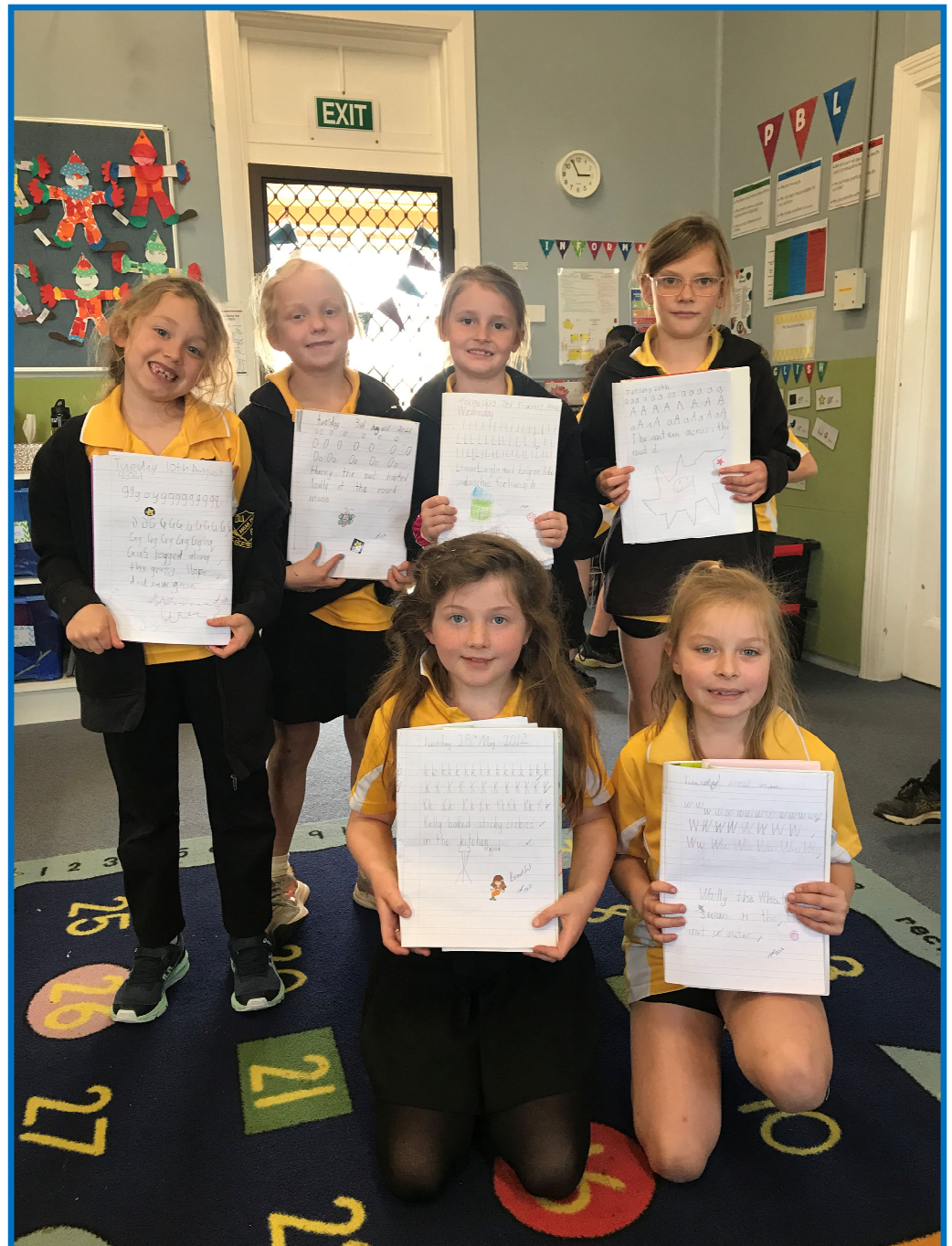

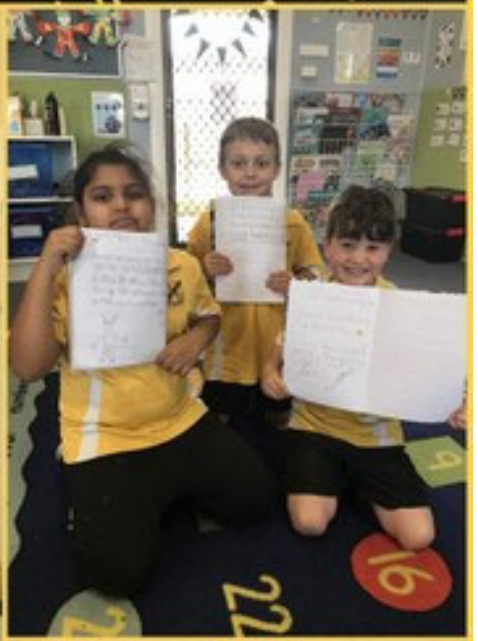
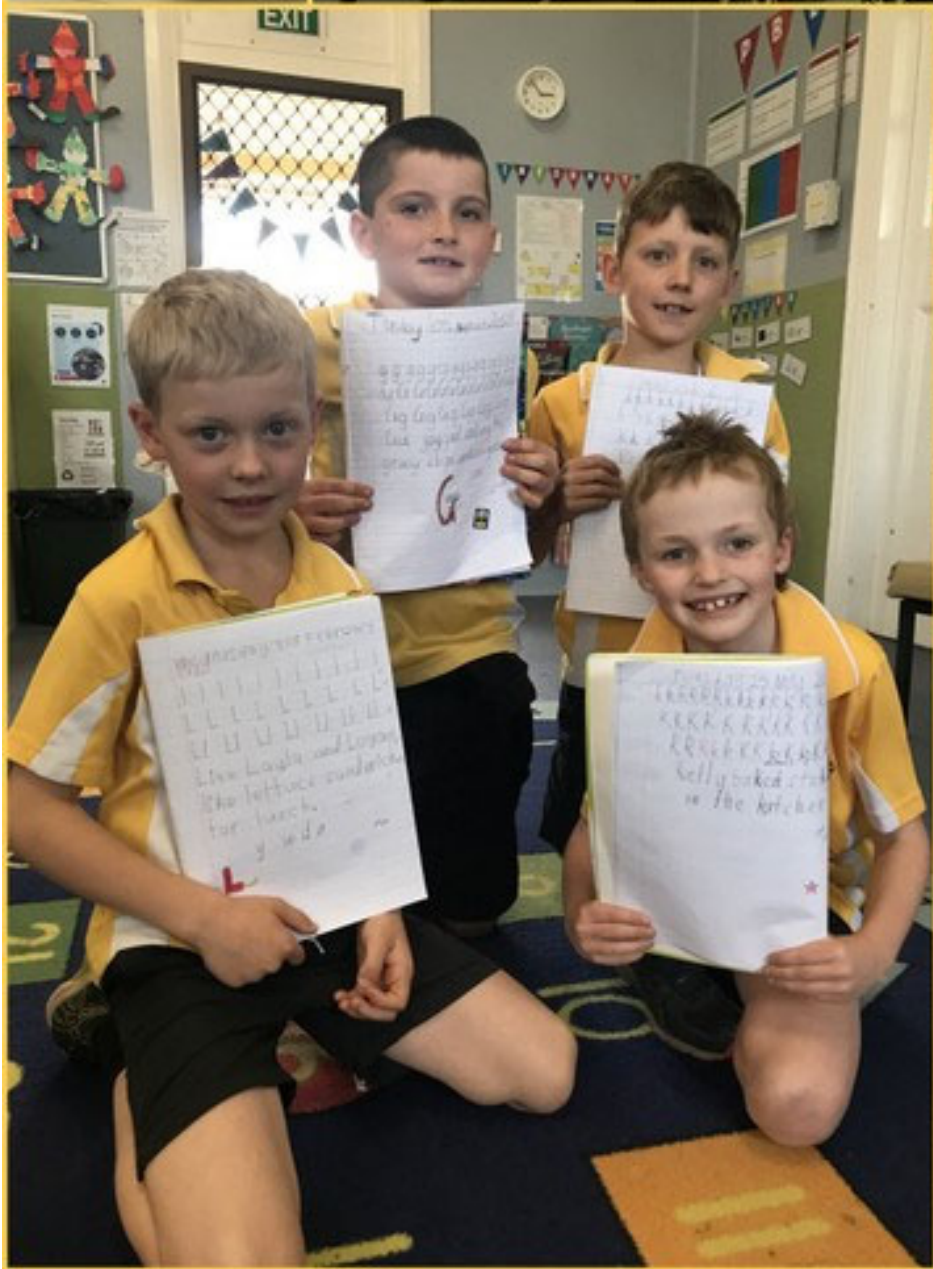
Year 2 Handwriting
