Important dates Term 1

- **Tuesday 1st February** is the first day for Kindergarten, Year 7, 11 & 12 (all other students return Wednesday 2nd February).
- The **Best Start Kindergarten Assessment** will be conducted in the first 5 weeks of Kindergarten. The Best Start Assessment identifies student's literacy and numeracy skills on entry to Kindergarten. The assessment is conducted in line with existing school practices and builds upon teaching and learning programs that support students in the transition to school.
- **APCS Swimming carnival** is in the first few weeks of school the date is TBA students wear their house colours (blue, green or red).
- Parent information session early next year to inform timetable items such as PE and Library days and all other classroom routines and information.
 For example: home reading, news days, classroom rewards and teacher contact information.

This position will be renumerated at \$150 per week.


