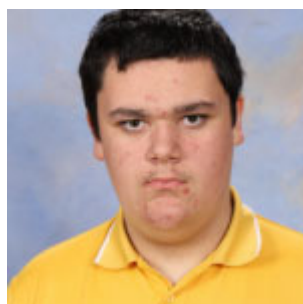
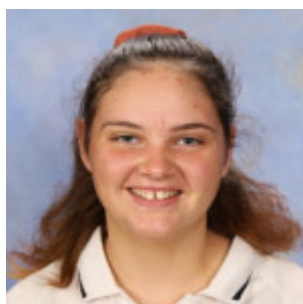

Kindergarten have been investigating capacity in Mathematics through hands on water play. They have also been focusing on the 'ay' sound and loved cooking fairy bread when looking at procedural texts.

Secondary News

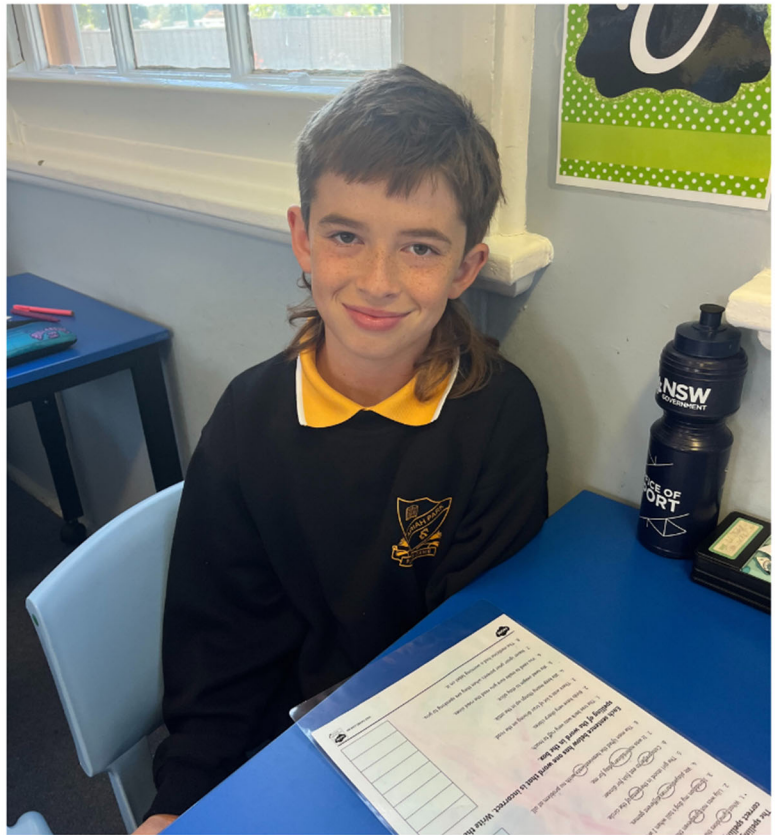

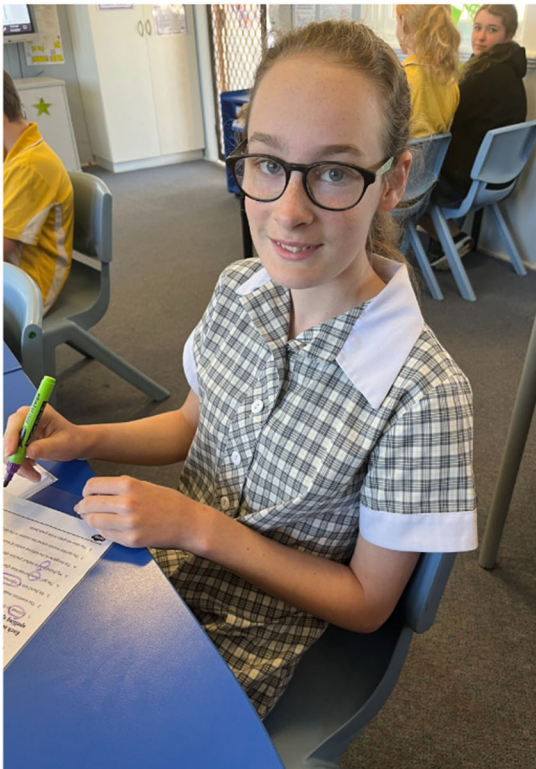

Information about swim club registrations for this season:

Memberships for the 2022/2023 season are:

✓ All families must have an adult registered. The adult can register as a non-swimmer.

➤ Non-Swimmer \$30

This membership is for parents or non-swimmers, coaches, committee members and officials.

➤ Training Swimmer \$90 (includes up to 4 race nights)

This membership allows swimmers to train at Ariah Park Swim Club and compete at a maximum of four Thursday race nights.

➤ AP Swim Club Swimmer \$110

This membership allows swimmers to train and compete at Ariah Park Swim Club level. This includes training, our regular Thursday race nights, and the Ariah Park Swim Club's carnival on 18th February 2023.

➤ AP Swim Club + External Carnivals Swimmer \$130

This membership is for swimmers who want to compete at Aria Park AND other club-run carnivals. This allows swimmers to compete at external competitive carnivals, as well as train and compete at Aria Park race nights and the Aria Park Swim Club's carnival on 18 February 2023.
