Please keep safe and have a wonderful productive week.















































Ariah Park Redbacks U13s Cricket Report

The Ariah Park Redbacks Under 13's continued their good early season form with a venomous 64 run win against Young Hilltop's Vegetation on Saturday at Young.

Ariah Park batted first and set an imposing total of 162 off their allotted 30 overs.

Jobe Davey (42 runs) and Liam Edis (24) got their team off to a great start sharing a 69 run partnership before both retired after 30 balls.

This was followed in the middle order by Cooper Herden, who scored a powerful 49 (also retiring) and Josh Davies, who made a handy 12.

Young's batting innings started disastrously and were soon in trouble deeper than the local potholes, decimated by openers Hayden Walsh and Leo Furphy, who both took early wickets.

Hamish Cochrane and Liam Edis both chimed in with 2 wickets each as Young eventually made 98.

The highlight of the bowling innings came right at the end when Debutant Logan Bell took his first wicket, and this was met with a jubilant mid-pitch celebration from his teammates to finish off the game.

The win makes it 3 out of 3 for the season for the Redbacks and they will take on the Gordon Winkley Warriors (Temora) in Ariah Park this Saturday.
