Camp Wombaroo Packing List

Clothing	
4 x Shirts	Appropriate and Sun Smart T-Shirt or long-sleeve, weather dependant.
4 x Bottoms	Appropriate and Sun Smart Shorts or pants, weather dependant.
2 x Jumper/Jacket	Just in case, weather dependant.
Underwear	1 pair per day, plus one extra.
Socks	1 pair per day, plus one extra. Thick woollen socks are great.
Pyjamas	1 set.
Hat	Wide brim.
Swimmers	Rashie (MUST BE INCLUDED) and Boardies.
2 x Shoes	Must be sturdy for walking, running, climbing, and hiking. Second pair in case shoes are wet/muddy from activities.
Thongs	For shower ONLY
Bedding/Personal	
Pillow	With pillowcase.
Sleeping Bag	
2 x Towels	1 bath and 1 beach towel
Toiletries	Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant (non-aerosol), shampoo and conditioner.

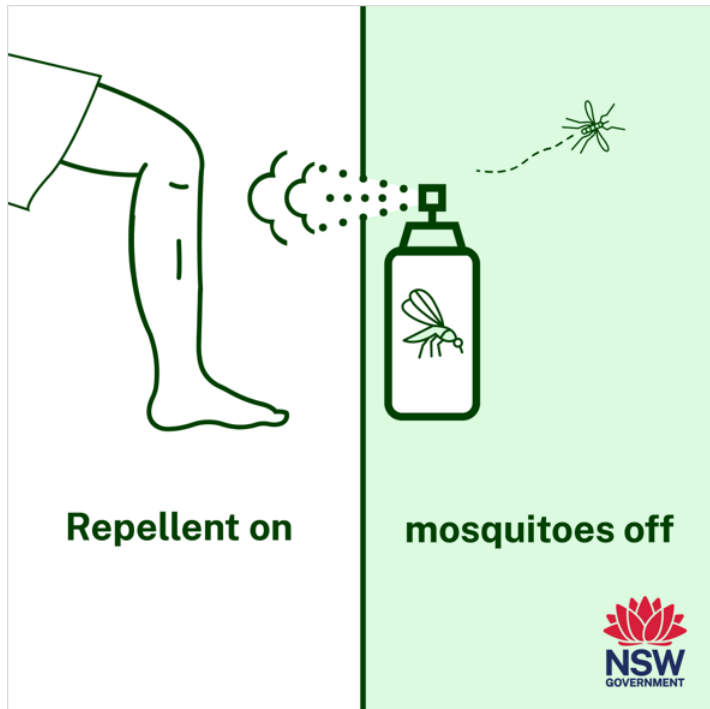
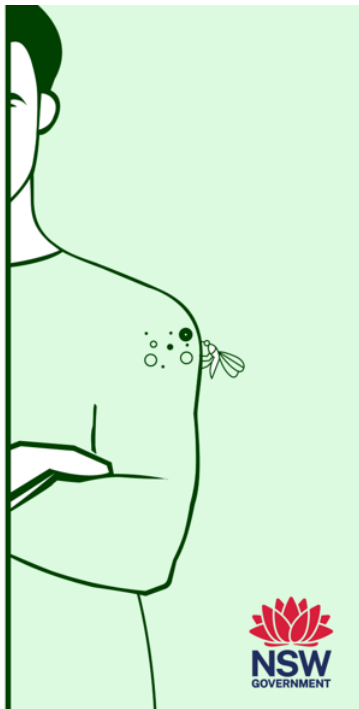

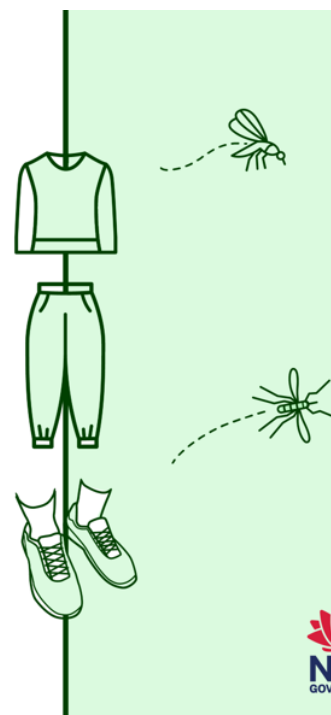

Ariah Park Redbacks U13s Cricket Report 26/11/22

Leo Furphy has taken an astonishing TRIPLE HAT-TRICK (5 wickets in 5 balls) to propel the Redbacks to their fifth straight win against ladder-leaders Nimbus Young on Saturday morning.

The Nimbus batting innings was action-packed and they looked like posting an imposing total after making their way to 5 for 123 after 22 overs. However Leo Furphy had other ideas as he began his 3rd over. The left-arm firebrand proceeded to tear the heart out of the opposition batting line-up taking the last 5 wickets in successive balls. A triple Hat-trick is a feat almost as rare as a Hayleys comet sighting- Well done Leo!

Hayden Walsh was also outstanding with the ball, producing his best performance of the year taking 3/9 off three overs with his clever out-swingers. The fielding was highlighted with superb catches to Fletcher Davey, Josh Davies and Cooper Herden.

In reply, the Redbacks coasted to victory on the back of 3 great innings from Cooper Herden (29 retired), Liam Edis (29) and Jobe Davey (27), passing the total 2 wickets down off 19 overs.

Ariah Park play the Cootamundra based team-Carmichael and Co at Ariah Park this Saturday.

Thankyou to everyone for working with us on the few changes we have made to our race nights.

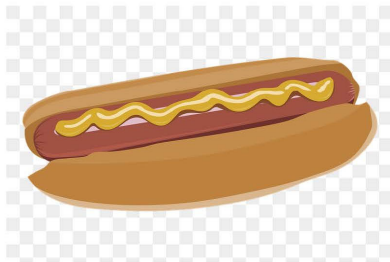
